SSI 2 RACE DAYS:

- (a) Autumn Rum Race Series; (9 April 2021 25 June 2021)
 - 12 Races
- (b) Winter Rum Race Series; (2 July 2021 24 September 2021)
 - 13 Races
- (c) **Spring Rum Race Series;** (I October 2021 17 December 2021)
 - 10 races No race on 22nd October
- (d) Summer Rum Race Series; (21 January 2022 1 April 2022)
 - 10 races No race on 11th February

SSI 3 THE START (SI 9)

- (a) The start line will be between the flagstaff on the Westhaven tower and the yellow Westhaven Buoy.
- (b) When a starting sequence is in progress, boats whose warning signal has not been made shall avoid the starting area. The starting area is defined as the area 50 metres from the starting line and marks in all directions.
- (c) A boat starting later than four minutes after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start without a hearing. This changes RRS A4.1

SSI 4 THE FINISH (SI 11)

- (a) During Autumn/Winter Series Westhaven Tower: The finish line will be from the flagstaff on the Westhaven Tower and the yellow Westhaven Buoy.
- (b) During Spring/Summer Squadron Tower: The finish line will be a transit line extending from the center of the Tower on the Eastern End of the Royal New Zealand Yacht Squadron Clubrooms and the yellow Westhaven Buoy. To finish boats must cross this line from the direction of the last mark, passing north of the yellow Westhaven Buoy.

SSI 5 TIME LIMITS (SI 12)

Fleet/Class	Time Limit for first finisher	Extension if one boat fishes within time limit
All divisions	2 hours	15 mins

There is no prescribed time limit for the first boat to pass mark 1.
