Amendment I:

- SSI 2.1 Add division "K" and warning signal of "1225" to race day 2, add warning signal of "1245" for all others.
- SSI 2.4 Add "2" after "Division K, the classics will join in race days"
- SSI 3.1 Remove "6" and add "7" for K Divisions "Number of Races Scheduled"
 Remove "1254" and add "1250" for M Divisions "Harbour Course Start Time Race Days 1 & 9"
 Add Division "Q" "Young 88" "9" "1319" "Y88 Class flag" to "Number of races, class flags & start times"
- SSI 3.3 Remove "Multihull" and add "Young 88" before "starts a minute ahead" and "shall have a 4-minute start sequence", and remove "A" and add C Light" before "division in Harbour courses", add "& Y88" after "Time to Sport Boat" remove "Multis" add "Young 88" to column "Time to Sport Boat & Y88 Start"
- SSI 4.1 Add "40Ft Racing (R) division shall race the same course as A division in Addendum A Harbour Courses."

Amendment 2:

SSI 2.1 Add division "Q" to Harbour Course Divisions

Amendment 3:

SSI 2.1 SSI 6.2 Add "Except for Race Day 2 where the finishing line will be between the committee boat and the yellow/black laid start mark. There will not be a separate finishing line."

SSI 1.1 All boats shall comply with any Covid19 requirements issued by RNZYS, Sport NZ and/or Yachting New Zealand. These will be posted in a Notice to Competitors.

- SSI 2.2 If the conditions are deemed unsuitable for W/L racing on race days 2-8 those divisions will be included in the Harbour course, warning signal and start times will revert back to as per Race Day 1.
- SSI 2.3 The Organising Authority may change the divisional structure based on the number of entries prior to the start of the first race.
- SSI 2.4 Division K, the classics will join in race days 1, 2, 3, 4, 6, 7 & 9.

- SSI 3.2 Divisional start times and order for Harbour courses will be confirmed via Notice to Competitors the day prior to racing. Windward/Leewards divisional start times in are shown in the table in SSI 2.1 The order following the first race may be changed on the water and will be advised on VHF channel 17. Up to 3 back to back windward/leewards are scheduled each race day.
- SSI 3.3 The Open Sports boat division starts a minute ahead of the MRX division and the Multihull Young 88 division starts a minute ahead of the A-division C Light division in Harbour courses, the Sport boats and Multihull Young 88 shall have a 4-minute start sequence as outlined below. All other divisions start sequences remain unchanged.

SSI 4 COURSES (SI 7)

- SSI 4.1 The Harbour courses to be sailed, the order in which the marks are to be passed, and the side on which each mark is to be left are shown in Addendum A Harbour Courses, in the RNZYS handbook and online at www.rnzys.org.nz. 40Ft Racing (R) division shall race the same course as A division in Addendum A Harbour Courses.
- SSI 4.2 The Windward Leeward Course description of the marks and courses are in the table in Attachment A. Noting that Mark I and Ia are ORANGE for divisions A, R, and YELLOW for divisions C, G & S.

SSI 5 THE START (SI 9)

- SSI 5.1 The start line will be between the RNZYS Signal Boat and the laid mark to the North.
- SSI 5.2 Wherever possible VHF Channel 17 may be used to advise OCS starters this does not absolve competitors of their responsibility to respond to the flag signals of the Race Committee.
- SSI 5.3 The Start Mark for the Windward Leeward Courses will be as described in Attachment A.

SSI 6 THE FINISH (SI II)

SSI 6.1 For Harbour courses the finish line will be between the flagstaff on the committee boat and the yellow Westhaven ODM Buoy.





SSI 6.2 For Windward/Leewards courses the finishing line will be as described in Attachment A. Except for Race Day 2 where the finishing line will be between the committee boat and the yellow/black laid start mark. There will not be a separate finishing line.


