1 RULES

- 1.1 The Race will be governed by the Rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 The Yachting New Zealand (YNZ) Safety Regulations (as below) shall apply:
 - a) Part II Category 5 shall apply, all boats shall either carry or tow a dinghy (fully inflated or rigid).
- 1.3 No spinnakers or extras may be set. Extras are defined as sails not normally used to advantage to windward. Headsails may be boomed out using spinnaker booms but shall only be carried on a permanent load bearing forestay with only one headsail per forestay.
- 1.4 Racing Rule 52 'Manual Power' shall not apply.
- 1.5 The Sailing Instructions will consist of the RNZYS Standard Sailing Instructions, found in the RNZYS Handbook and on the RNZYS website, and the Supplementary Sailing Instructions (SSI).
- 1.6 Appendix T, Arbitration, will apply.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 This is a closed event, every skipper must be a member of the RNZYS, and every boat must be on the RNZYS boat register.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing an entry form online at rnzys.org.nz, and a non-refundable entry fee shall be paid prior to racing.

3 FEES

4 SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

- 4.1 The scheduled time for the first warning signal will be 1255 for all race days, starting from Resolution Buoy.
- 4.2 Scheduled dates for racing are:

Race Day 1: 31st Oct	Race Day 2: 21st Nov	Race Day 3: 12th Dec
Race Day 4: 20th Feb	Race Day 5: 20th Mar	Race Day 6: 17th Apr

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 5.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available after Tuesday the 29th September online at www.rnzys.org.nz

6 VENUE

- 6.1 The races will be held within the Waitemata Harbour and the Hauraki Gulf.

7 COURSES

- 7.1 Courses as listed in Addendum B – CRUISING COURSES, in the RNZYS handbook and online.

8 SCORING

- 8.1 The races shall be scored as per RRS Appendix A using the Low Point system.
- 8.2 Series Scores; only series entrants will be eligible for series scores. This changes RRS A2.2.
- 8.3 One (1) race will be required to constitute a series, yachts will exclude their one (1) worst score after four (4) races.

9 RADIO COMMUNICATION

- 9.1 As a safety requirement, all boats must maintain a listening watch via VHF Radio on deck on channel 17 at all times while racing.

10 PRIZES

- 10.1 Prizes will be presented for line honours and for first, second and third on general handicap in each division at the post-race location approximately 1630hrs on the day of racing.
- 10.2 Other prizes may also be handed out for Spot Prizes, Best Dressed or Two Handed Sailing honours.
- 10.3 Series prize, the Islington Cup will be awarded to first on Handicap overall at the RNZYS Annual Prizegiving to be held on the Saturday 29th May 2021.

11.0 INSURANCE

- 11.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance.

12 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 12.1 All those taking part in RNZYS races or any other sailing events controlled by the RNZYS, as between the RNZYS and each of those so taking part, do so at their own risk and responsibility and the RNZYS and any sponsor associated with this event has no liability for any damage, loss or any penalty suffered by any boat crew or any other person taking part in such events. The RNZYS and any sponsor associated with this event shall not be responsible for the sea-worthiness of a boat whose entry is accepted and/or the sufficiency and/or adequacy of its equipment or the competence of its skipper or crew. The RNZYS reserves the right in its sole and uncontrolled discretion to refuse any entry.
