SUPPLEMENTARY SAILING INSTRUCTIONS (SSI)

This sheet and Addendum A – the RNZYS Harbour Courses are supplements to RNZYS Standard Sailing Instructions found in the RNZYS Handbook and on the RNZYS website.

RULES (SI I) SSI I

- 1.1 This is an open event, for members of any yacht club. The series is open to all Stewart 34 yachts that hold a current measurement certificate.
- 1.2 The Yachting New Zealand (YNZ) Safety Regulations Part II Category 5 shall apply.
- 1.3 For Division B, no spinnakers or extras may be set. Extras are defined as sails not normally used to advantage to windward. Headsails may be boomed out using spinnaker booms but shall only be carried on a permanent load bearing forestay with only one headsail per forestay
- 1.4 Any boat or equipment may be checked for compliance with the class rules and sailing instructions at any time. Whilst on the water, a boat can be instructed by a race committee measurer to proceed immediately to a designated area for inspection.

COURSES (SI 7)

SSI 3

- 3.1 The courses to be sailed are in Addendum A found online at www.rnzys.org.nz.
- 3.2 The selected course will be emailed to competitors on Friday the 14th May 2021 and texted to competitors on the morning of Saturday the 15th May 2021. Any course change will be texted to competitors prior to 1200 hrs and announced over VHF ch 17 prior to the first warning signal.
- 3.3 Racing will be cancelled for average wind levels above 28 knots.

MARKS (SI 8)

SSI 4 The marks will be Auckland harbour racing buoys.

THE START (SI 9)

SSI 5

- 5.1 The race will be started using RRS 26.
- 5.2 The start line will be between the flagstaff on the Westhaven Tower and the yellow Westhaven Buoy.





THE FINISH (SI II)

SSI 6 The finish line will be between the flagstaff on the Westhaven Tower and the yellow Westhaven Buoy.

TIME LIMITS (SI 12)

PROTEST AND REDRESS (SI 13)

SSI 8 For each division, the protest time limit is 60 minutes after the last boat has finished. Any protesting boat must inform the Race Officer their intention to protest before they leave the race course area.

PENALTY SYSTEM (SI 14)

SSI 9 Rule 44.1 is changed so the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by a One-Turn Penalty.

RADIO COMMUNICATION (SI 15)

SSI 10 Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

All radio communications between competitors and the Race Committee shall be through VHF Channel 17.
