**Amendment 1: Attachment A Windward Leeward Course – Start Mark changes from Orange to Yellow/Black**

### RULES

#### SSI 1

- 1.1 This is an open event, for members of any yacht club, the series is open to all keel boats meeting the requirements below;
- 1.2 The series is a women's only event; only one male is allowed on board whilst racing. He may give advice if requested but may not give any physical assistance except in an emergency. Any such assistance must result in the immediate retirement of the boat from the race.

### SCHEDULE OF RACES AND CLASS FLAGS (SI 5 & 6)

#### SSI 2

- 2.1 On W/L race days the Ladies fleet will join the Etchells fleet.
- 2.2 In the event that the conditions are deemed to be unsuitable for windward/leeward racing by the Race Officer, a harbor course will be run. This will be signaled from the RNZYS flag pole by flying code flags 'L' over 'H' with the Class Flag.

### COURSES (SI 3)

#### SSI 3

- 3.1 The courses to be sailed are shown in Appendix A attached to these SSI's, on race days 2-10 inclusive.
- 3.2 If course one is to be sailed, the numeral pennant "1" will be flown from the bow of the race committee boat at or before the warning signal. If course two is to be sailed, **no** numeral pennant will be flown.
- 3.3 On race days 1, the course to be sailed are in the RNZYS handbook and online at [rnzys.org.nz](http://rnzys.org.nz), all boats will sail the Division C course.

### MARKS (SI 8)

#### SSI 4

- 4.1 For W/L races the description of the marks and courses are shown in Appendix A as part of these SSI's.
- 4.2 For Harbour Courses the marks will be Auckland Harbour racing buoys as described in the Handbook and Addendum A – Harbour Courses 2010-21.

## THE START (SI 9)

### SSI 5

- 5.1 For Harbour Courses the start line will be between the flagstaff on the Westhaven Tower and the Yellow Westhaven ODM Buoy.
- 5.2 A boat starting later than four minutes after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start without a hearing. This changes RRS A4.1

## THE FINISH (SI 11)

- SSI 6** For Harbour Courses the finish line will be between the flagstaff on the Westhaven Tower and the Yellow Westhaven ODM Buoy.

## SAILS

- SSI 8** The following applies for MRX yachts only, the following restrictions apply when the flag is flown from the committee boat;

No flag	Selection of genoa and use of spinnaker up to individual skippers.
R flag	No. 2 genoa + spinnaker
K flag	No. 2 genoa + no spinnaker

### Course 1:

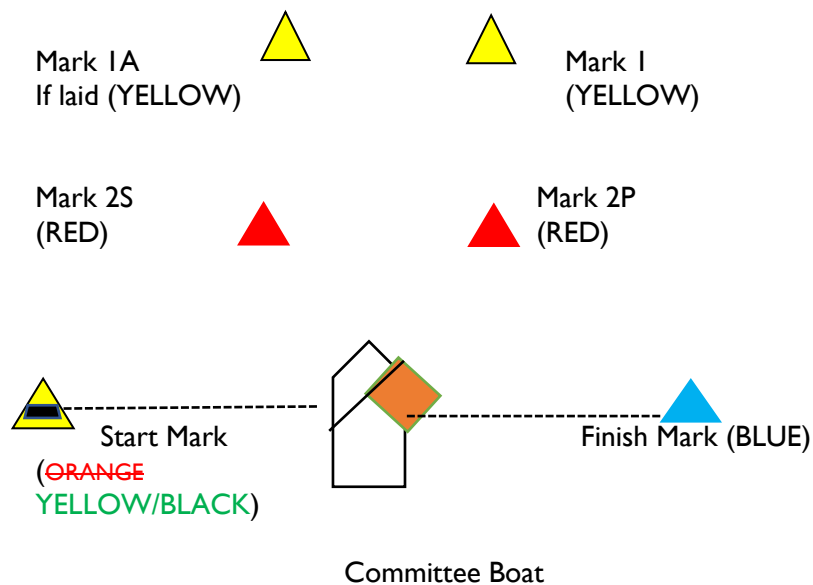
Start – Mark I – Mark Ia – Finish

### Course 2:

Start – Mark I – Mark Ia – 2s/2p – Mark I – Mark Ia – Finish

**All mark roundings to Port.**

**When a gate is laid, boats shall sail between the gate marks from the direction of the previous mark and round either gate mark.**



### CHANGE OF COURSE

For a change of course, a single green buoy will be used to replace mark I.
