COURSES (SI 7)

SSI 2.1 The courses to be sailed, the order in which the marks are to be passed, and the side on which each mark is to be left are shown in Addendum B – Cruising Courses, in the RNZYS handbook and online at rnzys.org.nz.

SSI 2.2 If course 11 is to be used, a notice to competitors will be issued with the new course instructions.

MARKS (SI 8)

SSI 3.1 The description of the marks is in Addendum B – Cruising Courses, are published in the RNZYS handbook and online at www.rnzys.org.nz.

THE START (SI 9)

SSI 4.1 To alert boats that a race or sequence of races will begin soon, the orange starting line flag will be displayed with one sound at least five minutes before a warning signal is made.

SSI 4.2 When a starting sequence is in progress, boats whose warning signal has not been made shall avoid the starting area. The starting area is defined as the area 50 metres from the starting line and marks in all directions.

SSI 4.3 A boat starting later than ten minutes after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start without a hearing.

THE FINISH (SI 11)

SSI 5.1 If there is no Finish boat on station, the first finishing boat must take GPS time on Finish, Anchor and take following competitors times.

TIME LIMITS (SI 12)

SSI 6.1

Race	Time Limit for first finisher	Extension if one boat fishes within time limit
Rally 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 & 6	3.5 hours	30 mins

There is no prescribed time limit for the first boat to pass mark 1.
