1 RULES

The Race will be governed by the Rules as defined in the 2017 – 2020 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will consist of the instructions in RRS Appendix S and the Supplementary Sailing Instructions (SSI) that will be posted on the RNZYS website on Monday the 25th September 2017.

3 ELIGIBILITY

3.1 This is an open event, for members of any yacht club, the series is open to all Stewart 34 yachts who hold a current measurement certificate.

Division	Requirements	Crew	Flag
A	Spinnaker	max 8 including the skipper	PINK
B	Non Spinnaker	max 5 including the skipper	GREEN

3.2 The Yachting New Zealand (YNZ) Safety Regulations Part II Category 5 shall apply.

3.3 Division B, no spinnakers or extras may be set. Extras are defined as sails not normally used to advantage to windward. Headsails may be boomed out using spinnaker booms but shall only be carried on a permanent load bearing forestay with only one headsail per forestay

4 ENTRY AND FEES

4.1 Eligible boats may enter by completing an entry form online at rnzys.org.nz, entry fees are paid by the Stewart 34 Association.

5 SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

5.1 The scheduled time the first warning signal will be 1755, Up to three (3) races are scheduled each race day. A total of 18 races are scheduled.

5.2 Scheduled date for racing are:

Race Day 1: 30th Oct	Race Day 2: 13th Nov	Race Day 3: 27th Nov
Race Day 4: 11th Dec	Race Day 5: 19th Feb	Race Day 6: 26th Feb

6 RACING AREA & COURSES

The races will be held within the Waitemata Harbour. The course to be sailed will be a windward leeward course as described in the SSI.

7 SCORING

- 7.1 The races shall be scored as per RRS Appendix A using the Low Point system.
- 7.2 Series Scores; only series entrants will be eligible for series scores. Twelve (12) races will be required to constitute a series, yachts will exclude their one (1) worst score after twelve (12) races, and exclude their two worst (2) scores after, eighteen (18) races.

8 PRIZES

- 8.1 Prizes will be presented for line honours and for first, second and third on general handicap in each division in the RNZYS clubrooms at approximately 2030hrs on the day of racing.
- 8.2 Series prizes will be awarded to first, second and third on line and Handicap overall at the series prize giving on Saturday 14th April 2018.
