I RULES

1.3

- 1.1 The racing will be governed by the Rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations (as below) shall apply:
 - a) Part II Category 5 shall apply for keel boats and multihulls
 - b) Part V Category B shall apply for trailer yachts
 - c) Part VII shall apply for sport multihulls
 - Racing Rule 52 'Manual Power' shall not apply.
- 1.4 Class rules apply for all class divisions.
- 1.5 For Div E No spinnakers or extras may be set. Extras are defined as sails not normally used to advantage to windward. Headsails may be boomed out using spinnaker booms but shall only be carried on a permanent load bearing forestay with only one headsail per forestay.
- 1.6 The Sailing Instructions will consist of the RNZYS Standard Sailing Instructions and the Supplementary Sailing Instructions (SSI).
- 1.7 Appendix T, Arbitration, will apply.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

2.1 This is an open event, for members of any yacht club, the series is open to all keel boats and multihulls that meet the requirements below;

- 2.3 Eligible boats may enter by completing an entry form online at rnzys.org.nz, a non-refundable entry fee shall be paid prior to racing.
- 2.4 Yachts wishing to sail under PHRF handicap must ensure that they have selected this on their entry and supplied their current PHRF registration number.

6 VENUE

6.1 The races will be held within the Waitemata Harbour.

7 COURSES

7.1 The course to be sailed will be a harbour course as listed in Addendum A – HARBOUR COURSES 2021-22, in the RNZYS handbook and online www.rnzys.org.nz

8 SCORING

- 8.1 Only series entrants will be eligible for series scores. This changes RRS A2.2.
- 8.2 One (I) race will be required to constitute a series.
- 8.3 Yachts will exclude their one (1) worst score after eight (8) races, and exclude their two worst (2) scores after ten (10) races.

9 RADIO COMMUNICATION

9.1 As a safety requirement, all boats must maintain a listening watch on VHF Radio channel 17 on deck at all times while racing.

10 PRIZES

- 10.1 Prizes will be presented for line honours and for first, second and third on general handicap in each division in the RNZYS clubrooms after racing on the day of racing.
- 10.2 Five (5) yachts must start the race in each division for a second prize to be awarded. Eight (8) yachts must start the race in each division for a third prize to be awarded.
- 10.3 Line honour prizes can only be collected at that prizegiving.
- 10.4 Series prizes will be awarded for line honours and for first, second and third on general handicap overall in each division at the series prizegiving on Wednesday 16 March 2022.
- 10.5 Series Plaques will be awarded for line honours and for first, second and third on general handicap and PHRF (if applicable) overall, at the RNZYS Summer Series Prizegiving on Saturday 21st May 2022, or posted out to boat owner/skippers.

II INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid marine third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover to \$5,000,000 per incident or the equivalent.

12 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

12.1 All those taking part in RNZYS races or any other sailing events controlled by the RNZYS, do so at their own risk and responsibility. The RNZYS and all sponsors associated with this event has no liability for any damage, loss or penalty suffered by any boat crew or other persons taking part in such events. The RNZYS and any sponsor associated with this event shall not be responsible for the sea-worthiness of a boat whose entry is accepted and/or the sufficiency and/or adequacy of its equipment or the competence of its skipper and/or crew. The RNZYS reserves the right in its sole and uncontrolled discretion to refuse any entry.
