1 RULES

The Race will be governed by the Rules as defined in the 2017 – 2020 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will consist of the instructions in RRS Appendix S and the Supplementary Sailing Instructions (SSI) that will be posted on the RNZYS website on Monday the 16th April 2018.

3 ELIGIBILITY

3.1 This is an open event, for members of any yacht club, the series is open to all keel boats and multihulls that meet the requirements below;

3.3 The Yachting New Zealand (YNZ) Safety Regulations Part II Category 5 shall apply for keel boats and multihulls.

3.2 The YNZ Safety Regulations Part V Category B shall apply for trailer yachts.

3.3 The YNZ Safety Regulations Part VII shall apply for sport multihulls.

3.4 Rule 52 'Manual Power' shall not apply.

3.5 For Div E - No spinnakers or extras may be set. Extras are defined as sails not normally used to advantage to windward. Headsails may be boomed out using spinnaker booms but shall only be carried on a permanent load bearing forestay with only one headsail per forestay.

4 ENTRY AND FEES

4.1 Eligible boats may enter by completing an entry form online at rnzys.org.nz, a non-refundable entry fee shall be paid prior to racing, Series entry fee: \$240 members | \$390 non-members. Individual race entry fee: \$25 members | \$45 non-members.

- 4.2 Yachts wishing to sail under PHRF handicap must ensure that they have selected this on their entry and supplied their current PHRF registration no.

5 SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

- 5.1 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first division will be 1250, The start times of each division will be in the SSI.

- 5.2 Scheduled date for racing are:

6 RACING AREA & COURSES

The races will be held within the Waitemata Harbour. The course to be sailed will be a mix of windward leeward course as described in the SSI. Harbour course as listed in Addendum A– HARBOUR COURSES, in the RNZYS handbook and online.

7 SCORING

- 7.1 The races shall be scored as per RRS Appendix A using the Low Point system.
- 7.2 Six (6) races will be required to constitute a series.
- 7.3 Series Scores; only series entrants will be eligible for series scores. Yachts will be excluded their one (1) worst score after eight (8) races, and exclude their two worst (2) scores after, ten (10) races.

8 PRIZES

- 8.1 Prizes will be presented for line honours and for first, second and third on general handicap in each division in the RNZYS clubrooms at approximately 2045hrs on the day of racing.
- 8.2 Five (5) yachts must start the race in each division for a second prize to be awarded. Eight (8) yachts must start the race in each division for a third prize to be awarded.
- 8.3 Line honour prizes can only be collected at that prize giving.
- 8.4 Series prizes will be awarded for line honours and for first, second and third on general handicap and PHRF overall in each division at the series prize giving on Saturday 22nd September 2018.
