SUPPLEMENTARY SAILING INSTRUCTIONS - V2

This sheet, including attachments, and Addendum C – RNZYS Commodore's Cup Course are supplements to the RNZYS Standard Sailing Instructions found on the RNZYS website and in the RNZYS Handbook.

AMENDMENTS:

Changes from the previous version are marked in red.

AI 5.2 – Removal of Race 5 start from this section (20 November 2023).

1 RULES (SI I)

- 1.1 For race 2 RRS 40.1, Personal Floatation Devices shall apply at all times.
- 1.2 Should there be any conflict between the Notice of Race (NOR) or the RNZYS Standard Sailing Instructions and these Supplementary Sailing Instructions (SSIs), the SSIs shall prevail.
- 1.3 If Y flag is flown from the RNZYS flagpole, then it is mandatory for all sailors across all divisions and fleets to wear PFDs.

2 NOTICES TO COMPETITORS (SI 2) & SIGNALS MADE ASHORE (SI 4)

2.1 For race 3, Kawau Courses, signals made ashore will be displayed from Lidgard House.

4 COMMUNICATIONS

- 4.1 [DP] All boats shall maintain a listening watch on VHF channels 16 & 77.
 - (a) Channel 77 is to be used for race event communication.
 - (b) Channel 16 must be used for emergency communication.
- 4.2 In an emergency, the boat in distress must request assistance via VHF channel 16 for the

Coastguard and Emergency Services to be alerted.

- 4.3 For race 2, all yachts are required to call the Race Committee via VHF Radio Ch 77 to check in prior to the start sequence.
- 4.4 For race 2, all yachts are required to call the Race Committee via VHF Radio Ch 77 when approaching the finish line.

5 START TIMES AND CLASS FLAGS (SI 6)

5.1 For race 2 and 5 the scheduled start time is as follows:

6 COURSES (SI 7)

6.1 The courses are shown in the RNZYS Course Addendum C online at the RNZYS website at www.rnzys.org.nz. They show the courses, the order in which rounding marks are to be passed, and the side on which each mark is to be left.

7 THE START (SI I I)

- 7.1 For race 3 the starting line is between the flagstaff displaying an orange flag on the race committee vessel moored approx. 0.5nm west of the entrance to Bon Accord Harbour andthe course side of a large yellow/black inflatable starting mark.
- 7.2 For races 1, 2, 4 and 5 the starting line is between the flagstaff displaying an orange flag on the Westhaven Tower and the course side of the yellow Westhaven buoy.

8 THE FINISH (SI 13)

- 8.1 For races 1, 2, 4 and 5, the finishing line is between the flagstaff displaying a blue flag on the Westhaven Tower and the course side of the yellow harbour racing buoy Westhaven.
- 8.2 For race 3, the finishing line is between the flagstaff displaying a blue flag on the race committee vessel moored approx. 0.5nm west of the entrance to Bon Accord Harbour andthe course side of the port end finishing mark.

9 PENALTY SYSTEM (SI 14)

9.1 For the multi-hull classes RRS 44.2 is changed so the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by a One-Turn Penalty.

11 PROTEST HEARINGS (SI 16)

11.1 For each division, the protest time limit is 2 hours after the last boat finishes or the Race Committee signals no more racing today, whichever is the later. The same protest time limit applies to all protests by the race committee.
